**Presentation:** Entries to be hung must be suitably framed and wired for hanging. Gallery wrapped canvases must be staple-free on the front and sides and minimally one and on-half inches deep. Saw tooth hangers will not be accepted. WET PAINTINGS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED. School student art to be hung does not need to be framed. However, it does need to be matted and have a firmly attached wire or string hanger, please no saw tooth hangers or scotch taped strings. Free-standing works and sculptures are to be placed on display by the artist during the March 13, 2010 receiving period. Entrants of unusually large pieces should provide their own easels.

**Registration Form:**  
The Medium column should be completed with the actual medium used. For example, please be more explicit with the term "mixed". Is it water and ink, etc.  
The height and width of the piece should reflect outside dimensions if a framed piece. LSAG uses this information to determine how many hanging flats they will need.

**Suitability:** The Tomball Art League retains the right to refuse acceptance of any work deemed not suitable or qualified for display or public viewing by a majority vote of the TAL Officers present when receiving the work for the show. **Because of the show location and the large number of young student entrants, nudes and semi-nudes will not be accepted for this show.**

**School Students:** Because of space limitations, school student art is limited to 10 pieces per school. Art teachers for students are asked to sign the Registration Form confirming it is the student's original work. Parents may sign the registration form for home schoolers. A SEPARATE REGISTRATION FORM FOR SCHOOL STUDENTS IS ATTACHED. For student artwork, a \$2.00 registration fee for each piece will be charged. Maximum limits do not apply to school students.

**Entry Fees:** To encourage more entries, TAL will only charge entry fees for the first FIVE entries, additional entries will be free.

\$5.00 TAL Members (\$25.00 max)

\$7.00 other LSAG members (\$35.00 max)

\$8.00 Non-LSAG members (\$40.00 max)

\$2.00 School Students – maximum limits do not apply to school students.

**ENTRIES THAT HAVE NOT BEEN PRE-REGISTERED BY MONDAY MARCH 8, 2010 WILL BE CHARGED AN ADDITIONAL \$2.00 PER ENTRY AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION DURING THE RECEIVING TIMES ON MARCH 12 AND 13, 2010.**
